CHANDLER CONRAD - Grobert

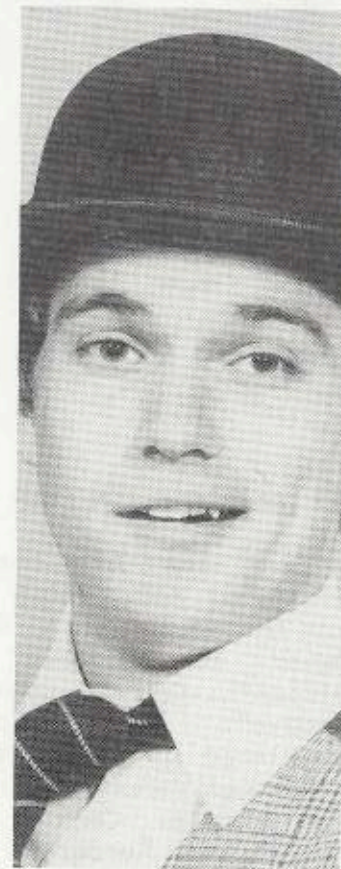

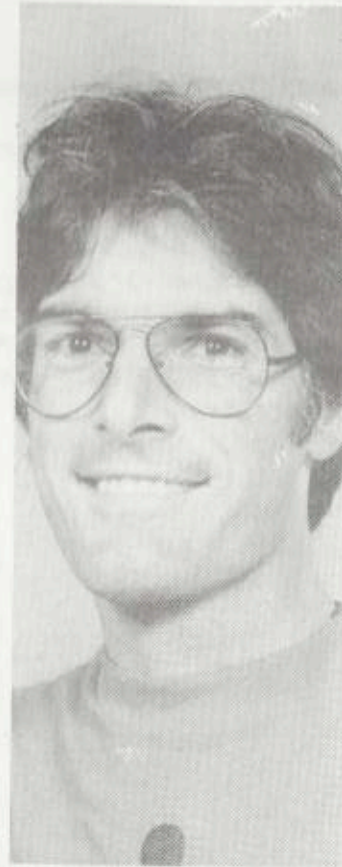

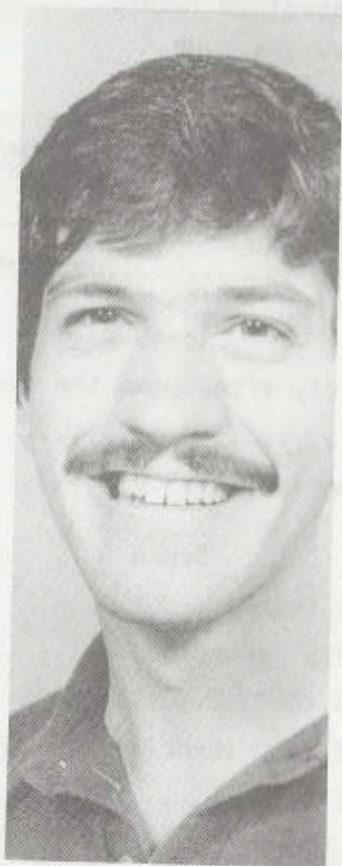
RAY RUSSELL - Dr. Glass/Balloon Vendor

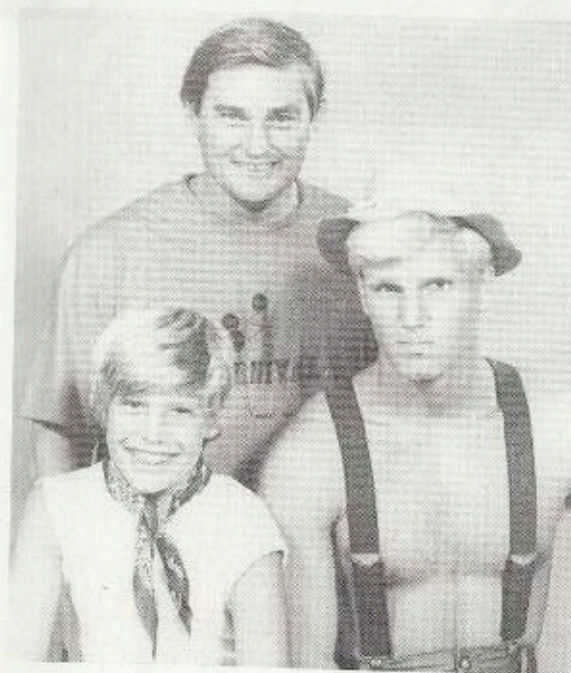

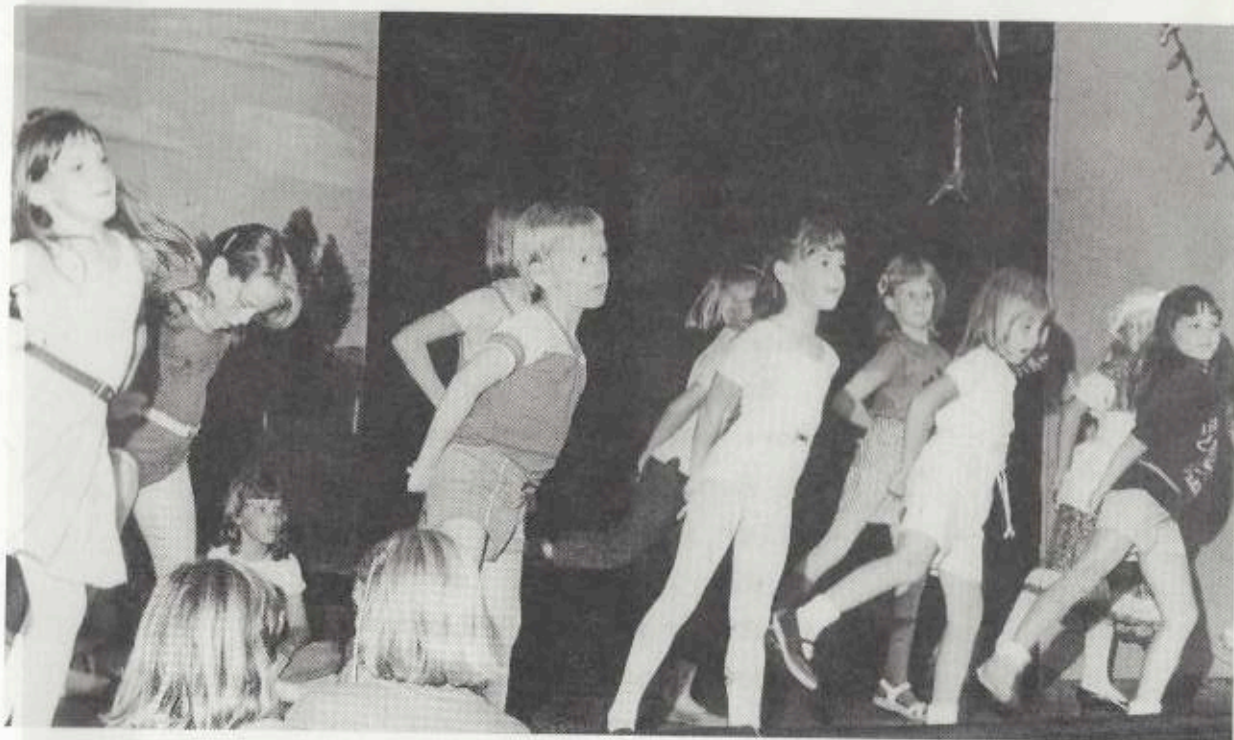
