

The director and producers of NO TIME FOR SERGEANTS bring nearly five (5) decades of on-the-job-training to the effort, which provides them a rich data base of experience in coping with the frequently absurd situations one encounters in military life. And, as you will note, there is inter-service representation for insuring the technical accuracy of the play, which can be described as a summary of absurd situations; in fact, this entire operation -- classified Top Secret Nerd -- has been designated as project ASSININE -- Absurd Situation Summaries Involving Interservice Examples.

The Navy is represented by Director Charlie STOWE, who, as a fighter/attack pilot was known as Commander Tuna -- chicken of the sea; the Army, by producer Guy HATLIE, who as the quintessential combat helicopter pilot gave new meaning to the phrase "we have met the enemy and they are us"; and, finally, the Air Force (nee Farce?) -- which this tale is mostly about -- is justly represented by MBCC's own Yossarian (remember Catch 22; "...you can't fly if you're insane, but you have to be insane to want to fly..") co-producer J. C. EDWARDS. That these three former officers of our nation's front line of defense have devoted their energies to entertaining you tonight must certainly give you a warm feeling that the creeping claws of Communism are being kept at bay.

As you will note, there is a fixation on toiletry in operation ASSININE. This probably reflects the author's conviction that the script should focus on that which the military does best. And to carry forth that objective, there are no better qualified individuals than these three fine officers — and gentlemen? But it is quickly pointed out that the toilet seats you see tonight did not — repeat NOT — cost \$7,500, which was the quoted price first received from the usual supply sources. Instead, they were requisitioned using rather, ah, unconventional supply techniques known only to pilots and officers' club managers. To provide functional utility to the toilets — as you will observe — another 20 year veteran Navy pilot, Bruce Thorkelson, was ordered in from COMARINERPAC on TAD/ACDUTRA. This provided nearly 70 years cumulative military experience for ASSININE implementation.

The strategic objective for operation ASSININE is based on pure brute force; "give'm the whole nine yards", as HATLIE ordered in his pre-attack directive to all hands. Therefore you <u>WILL</u> enjoy the show or be subject to penalties ranging from Captain's Mast, through General Court-Hartisl, to termination with extreme prejudice.

Keith and Glenda have been 'active' in the church and the Mariners (if one wins the Spittoon, one is 'active'!) and it was during the late summer of 1986 that the script for NO TIME FOR SERGEANTS landed Keith his first attempt at the stage. Playing the role of Private Ben Whitledge in this MBCC production has, in Keith's own words, opened up a whole world of opportunity for me".
