

She is a graduate of Occidental College (Theatre), State University of Iowa (M.A., Theatre), the "Sandpiper Follies," "Oklahoma" at El Camino ('83), and 23 years with the Stowe Shows. Maybe you can identify some comical touches she used as the director of "Never Say Goodbye" here three years ago. She and her husband, Jim, (trombone section) still play tennis, sail and travel...but only after the May musicals!





CHARLIE STOWE, Music Director - As evidenced in the picture, this show has aged Charlie quite a bit. Though he's never exactly been confused with Santa Claus or J.C., (some think there's a likeness to the Ayotallah Khomini) he has always had greybeard tendencies.

He began as a young man in MBCC musicals ... nearly 30 years ago...in the trombone section of a Grossman/Brown production. From there he made the mistake of picking up a baton, and later compounded it by climbing the stage steps for a few shows...(early) Music Man, I Do, I Do, Never Say Goodbye. After being told that the only stage he should be on is the one leaving for Cutbank, Mont., he graciously moved back down to spear snakes and alligators with his baton in the orchestra pit. His next move is obvious; to disappear into the trombone section from whence he came. When that happens, perhaps he will have found the fountain of youth.
