





### THE CAST

Florence Martin Petite, effervescent, non-conforming, [Maria Rainer] Florence is ideally cast in the lead. In real life she has trained each of the von Trapp children in the church's Carol Choir. She has performed in and out of the church as soloist. As a dramatist her last two roles were as trees in Hansel & Gretel and Finians Rainbow. How nice to have her in the LEAD.

Paul Tanksley Open, congenial, humorous, Paul has (Captain von Trapp) sung bass with the Senior Choir and has served with the U. S. Navy as a pilot. The transition to an Austrian Naval captain is ever so slight. Paul's dramatic credits include the Sandpiper Follies Review, camping in the mountains and waterfowl hunting.

Barbara Hammer 'Tis a shame to break up the con-(The Mother Abbess) tinuity of theatrical inexperience with Barbara. To play the warm, understanding Mother Abbess, Barbara can draw on her Master's Degree in music and many appearances in MBCC plays: Amahl and the Night Visitors, Music Man, the Curious Savage and many more. She is also heading the makeup department.

Peter Quass Peter has played the fool for years - (Max Detweiler) as Sancho in Man of La Mancha and in The Terrible Turners, The Man Who Came to Dinner, etc. Playing Max, the promoter with no patriotic principles who follows the line of least resistance, is more of a challenge. His theatrical prowess and humor far exceeds his girth.

Pat Edwards Oily, sophisticated, very class [Elsa Schraeder] conscious, a femme fatale. This is Pat Edwards? Hardly! Her line of work is more like directing the Children's Choirs & the Contemporary Chorale at MBCC. She has also appeared in "Man From La Mancha" and "The Curious Savage" as well as soloist in the Church Choir. She sang with the Roger Wagner Chorale & played the Mother in "Amahl and the Night Visitors".


